- Funding requested - \$4.1 million





# TIGER Discretionary Grant

The allocation of funds will be:

- Florida - \$1,800,000
- City of Reno - \$ 900,000
- City of Peoria - \$ 900,000
- Sub-Awards - \$ 500,000
- Total - \$4,100,000





# TIGER Discretionary Grant

- Project Description

This pilot will demonstrate the effectiveness of an innovative off-grid, natural gas fueled electricity generation system that solves the problems with the emerging electric vehicle (“EV”) transportation market and its recharging needs.

- This TIGER Discretionary Grant request is seeking American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) stimulus funding to create and test the needed infrastructure for the next mode of alternative fuel vehicles (“AFV”) which include EV’s and plug-in hybrid electric vehicles (“PHEVs”).





# TIGER Discretionary Grant

- Six PODs\* will be deployed in Florida,
  - Two in Tallahassee
  - Two in Boca Raton, and
  - Two in Delray Beach;
  - Three will be placed in Peoria, and three in Reno and Sparks
